Fees due upon arrival.

- 1 No exhibitor shall be allowed to submit more than two entries per lot.
- 2 Exhibitors must keep their stock, stalls and pens in neat condition and open for inspection from 10:00 am each day.
- 3 Exhibitors of livestock must be in the show ring promptly after being called, and any exhibitor failing to comply with this order will be ruled out of the competition.
- 4 Exhibitors must purchase parking permits and pay an entry fee of \$5.00 per entry.
- 5 All animals for exhibition shall be shown to the judges under supervision of the respective superintendents.
- 6 Stalls will be assigned in the order that application is made, first come, first serve. Sawdust for bedding is recommended for disposal purposes.
